Opportunities available






Thinking about what to do after Year 11 or supporting someone who is? Then What Next Sussex is for you.

Those looking to become a plumber will need to find out issues from the customer and come up with solutions to fix this. The individual would give time and estimates for jobs responding to emergency call-outs.
