## Year 11 Post-16 Progression Evening 26th September 2024

Dear Year 11 Families

Before the end of the Autumn term, students in Year 11 will need to have either

- applied to college for a September 2025 place
- or be in the process of applying for an apprenticeship.

The choice they make for their Post 16 route is obviously very important and the range of opportunities is quite broad.

We wish to support students as much as possible, and to this end you and child are cordially invited to a Post-16 Progression Evening on Thursday 26th September.

The evening will run between 6.30pm-8.30pm. There will be an introduction by Ms Claydon followed by a talk by staff from both BHASVIC and Varndean College in the theatre at 6.45pm and 7.45pm. There is no need to attend more than once.

The event will include representatives from a wide range of local Post 16 colleges and apprenticeship providers. This will allow students to investigate different progression options and talk with people in the best position to advise them about their specific college or company. It will help your family identify which colleges or apprenticeship providers are worth further investigation.

To ensure accessibility to all the providers and to avoid congestion, we ask that you either sign in at the West Wing Reception area or the Music Foyer, in the central block.

Students and parents/carers will be free to visit the different providers' stands and meet their representatives. The list of confirmed providers for the evening, plus their locations on the night, are overleaf. More providers may well be added between now and the evening itself. Equally if you have any providers not listed that you would be interested in talking to, please let us know.

Every college has an Open Evening and many of these will be this term. Dates and times of these are attached. Please check individual websites to see if you need to book a place. Some of the open evenings can be very busy, thus making it difficult to access all the information you need. Our event is a chance to meet college staff and potential employers informally and ask questions pertinent to your own child.
